

**TOWN OF DUNE ACRES
PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT (CCD) FUND TAX RATE
March 19, 2019**

The Town of Dune Acres Town Council conducted a Public Hearing on Tuesday, March 19, 2019, at the Town Hall. Council President Rich Hawksworth opened the hearing at 7:00 p.m., with Council Members Alexander Stemer, Clerk-Treasurer Jeannette Bapst, and Attorney Adam Mindel representing Dan Whitten in attendance.

PUBLIC INPUT ON NEW CUMULATIVE CAPITAL DEVELOPMENT FUND TAX RATE

The Town Council had advertised the “Notice to Taxpayers of Hearing on Proposed Cumulative Capital Development Fund” tax rate. The notice was published in *The Times* and *Chesterton Tribune* on February 25, 2019 and March 5, 2019. It was posted on the town website, and posted in four locations in town. In addition, a “Frequently Asked Questions” document was provided to residents on the town website.

The Town Council is proposing a CCD rate .0350 per \$100 assessed valuation.

Approximately 15 residents attended the hearing. Three emails received from residents who could not attend the hearing were read aloud. Two emails opposed and/or questioned the increase, one was strongly in favor. Attending residents spoke in favor of the increase and in opposition to the increase.
