COMMISSIONERS REPORTS:

BUILDING: Building Commissioner Tom Roberts had recommended approval of Building Permit #2020-26, 35 Crest Drive, \$29,000 paving replacement, Building Permit #2020-27, 18 East Road, \$44,500 roof replacement, Building Permit #2020-31, 8 Summit Road interior

renovations and room extension, and Building Permit #2020-32, 3 Shore Drive \$22,000 window and door replacement. It was moved and seconded to approve the recommendations. Motion passed unanimously.

BEACH COMMISSIONER: Beach Commissioner Carstens reported all safety buoys had been removed for the season, with one buoy lost over the summer. South Shore Marina's service quote for the 2021 season, including equipment replacement, totals \$5,215.

Carstens said he was researching the establishment of designated swimming beaches that would prohibit motorized watercraft as discussed at previous meetings. He will report on progress at future meetings.

ENVIRONMENTAL: Environmental Commissioner Robin Tennant was recognized by President Hawksworth for conducting another successful Town Cleanup.

<u>Destruction of Public Records, State Form 44905</u>. It was moved and seconded to approve the destruction of public records as listed on State Form 44905 presented by the Clerk-Treasurer and in accordance with the Indiana Records Retention Schedule. Motion passed unanimously. Bapst will submit required documentation to County and State agencies.

<u>Resolution #2020-04 Holiday Pay</u>. It was moved and seconded to approve Resolution #2020-04, Holiday. Motion passed unanimously. The resolution provides a holiday stipend to qualifying maintenance and security employees as outlined in Ordinance.

<u>Authorization to Dispose of Town Property – Kawasaki Mule</u>. As had been recommended by Maintenance Commissioner Dick Taylor, it was moved and seconded to dispose of the Town's Kawasaki Mule following procedures outlined in Indiana Code. Motion passed unanimously. Bapst will publish required legal notices and facilitate the sale to the highest bidder.

South Shore Clean Cities, Indiana Office of Energy Development *Public Safety Resilience Grant*. Bapst provided information on a Town grant submitted in collaboration with South Shore Clean Cities, a not-for-profit that serves government agencies with clean energy initiatives, that would offset costs of a gasoline/electric hybrid security vehicle. Award notifications are expected in November.

<u>Clubhouse Rental</u>. A motion was made and seconded to approve a June 25-26-27, 2021 clubhouse rental. Motion passed unanimously.

<u>Dune Acres Trick or Treat</u>: It was agreed by consensus to conduct the Town Trick or Treat on October 31, 2020 between the hours of 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM.

OTHER BUSINESS:

<u>Voting Information</u>: Discussion was held regarding voting locations and times available to residents, noting the Dune Acres Town Hall was not scheduled as a poling location this election. Bapst was instructed to repeat an earlier email to residents listing the November 3 election day site, as well as in-person absentee locations.
